3 Two Washington House Members Sign Amicus Brief

Two members of Congress from our state, Republican Reps. Cathy McMorris Rodgers and Dan Newhouse, have joined more than 200 GOP colleagues in an amicus brief urging the U.S. Supreme Court to "reconsider" its landmark 1973 Roe v. Wade decision that made abortion legal across America.

The brief argued there is a "need for the Court to again take up the issue of whether Roe and Casey should be reconsidered and if appropriate overruled." The 1992 Planned Parenthood vs. Casey decision, work of three centrist justices, upheld and affirmed the right of a woman to choose.

6 Mileage Tax Bill Expected



In December the Washington State Transportation Commission voted to move forward with recommendations for a proposed "pay-by-the-mile" tax to replace the state's current gas tax. *note to self: they won't really drop the gas tax* We expect a bill to be dropped this legislative session reflecting this new tax. 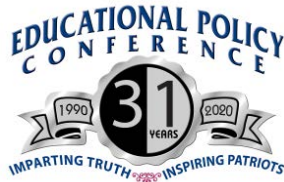
"For 21 years, I've put initiatives on the ballot and voters voted on them, but the people we elect refuse to listen. Therefore, I am running for Governor in 2020."
