Informed Voters Must Know the Taxing Reality of Initiative 1631



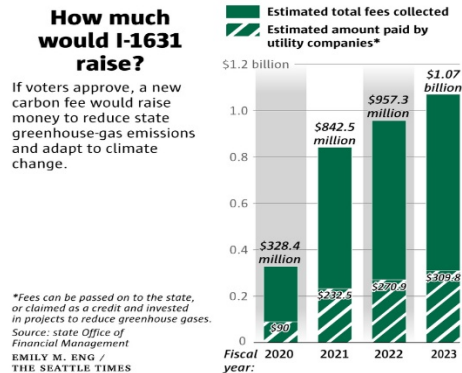
Washington Policy center has released their Citizen's Guide to Initiative 1631. The taxing reality of I-1631 if passed in November will be staggering for WA citizens:

1. Initiative 1631 would impose a carbon tax of \$15 per metric ton of CO₂ emitted in Washington state, increasing by \$2 per year plus inflation, to over \$40 per metric ton in about ten years.
2. Taxpayers would see the cost of the initiative primarily at the gas pump, in home heating costs, and on their electricity bills.
3. This translates to between \$234 and \$305 for the average household in the first year, increasing to \$672 and \$877 per year after ten years.
4. The largest portion of the cost would come from a 14-cent-per-gallon gas tax that would increase by about two cents per gallon each year.
